



# Inter-Municipal BUSINESS LICENSES



## What is it?

An inter-municipal business license allows you to **operate in any Yukon municipality** without having to buy separate business licenses in each community.

## Do you need one?

Do you plan on working in **two or more municipalities** across the Yukon? If so, an inter-municipal business license may be for you.



## How to get one:



Go to your closest municipality  
(your 'home' community)



Purchase a business license



Purchase an inter-municipal business license from any Yukon municipality  
(usually your 'home' community)

## EXCLUSIONS:



**Most food-based businesses** cannot operate under an inter-municipal business license due to individual community regulations.



If your business has an **office or physical location in 2 or more communities**, then you cannot operate under an inter-municipal business license.



If the business is **not a Yukon business**.

## Commonly asked questions:

### Does AYC sell inter-municipal business licenses?

No. AYC does not sell inter-municipal business licenses. We maintain a record of current inter-municipal business license. Licenses can be purchased at any municipal administrative office.

### I don't live in a municipality, how do I get one?

Go to your closest municipality. I.E. if you lived in Carcross you could go to Teslin or Whitehorse to purchase a business license and inter-municipal business license.

### Who can answer my inter-municipal business license questions?

The manager of operations at AYC can answer most questions about inter-municipal business licenses. Your closest municipality can also probably answer any questions you have.

### Do I need a business license first?

Yes, in order to purchase an inter-municipal business license you need to provide proof of having a valid business license.
